



\$1,000 Scholarship For Students Studying in a Healthcare Field

Applicants are eligible for \$1,000 to be used for college supplies such as books, a computer, or other supplies needed for academic study.

Eligibility Checklist: Applicant must fulfill all criteria to be eligible for scholarship and submit required resume and essay.

Be accepted to a college or trade school

Have plans to graduate with a specific healthcare-related degree that would lead to future employment in hospital or clinic setting.

Be a graduating senior enrolled in Osage, Riceville, or St. Ansgar school districts.

Award winners must present a receipt of purchase, or collection of receipts of college material, supplies/books/computer (preferably purchased from the college book store) to the Foundation Board for approval. After the receipt(s) has been deemed reliable, a check payable to the student for the total purchase (up to \$1,000 total for four years) will be awarded to the student.
