

\$1,000 Scholarship For Students Studying in a Healthcare Field

Eligibility Checklist: Applicant must fulfill all criteria to be eligible for scholarship and submit required resume and essay.

Specific Criteria:

- √ Be accepted to a college/trade school
- √ Have plans to graduate with a healthcare-related degree in a specific area.
- √ Be a student enrolled in Osage, Riceville, or St. Ansgar School Districts (graduating seniors only)

Award winners must present a receipt of purchase, or collection of receipts of college material, supplies/books/computer (preferably purchased from the college book store) to the Foundation Board for approval.

After the receipt(s) has been deemed reliable, a check payable to the student for the total purchase (up to \$1,000 total for four years) will be sent to the student.
